OUR GROWING LEADERSHIP AND MENTORSHIP PROGRAM

The WVI DF and partners have built a unique hybrid – in-person and virtual Leadership and Life Skills Mentorship Program wherein volunteer mentors including celebrity athletes, veterans, and exclusive thought leaders – support underserved youth, Blue and Gold-Star mentees – ages 15-18 – by combining their remarkable stories of overcoming adversity with a character development curriculum.



All modules include program content that prioritizes the virtues of leadership as service, job readiness, entrepreneurship, financial literacy and character and life skills development.

After completing 3 out of 4 modules over the course of the year, our mentees receive a Leadership Certificate that supports their college / trade school applications and / or job opportunities. The WVI Dolphin Foundation then provides introductions to our network of companies and organizations that may provide internships, employment, and other referrals.

The individual STEM modules below provide our mentees with these deliverables:

1. An overview of CAREER PATHS and their FINANCIAL REWARDS:

- Manufacturing
- Aviation & Aerospace
- Life Sciences
- 2. Clarity on the TRAINING AND SPECIFIC EDUCATIONAL RESOURCES required to attain success
- 3. Following the completion of 3 MODULES, mentees earn LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATES that will boost college / trade school applications and job opportunities
- 4. Certificate Awardees receive DIRECT INTRODUCTIONS TO CORPORATE AND INDUSTRY DECISION MAKERS within our ecosystem.

Mentees come from the tri-state area and from organizations such as the NY Army National Guard, the NYPD Explorers program, and from local school districts and community organizations.

EXPERIENTIAL OPPORTUNITIES FOR MENTEES

The STEM portion of our program – and its curricula – is led by a fantastic team of STEM Volunteer Advisors and point-persons who guide our program decisions toward strategic impact for mentees. With their dedication and resourceful input, our STEM modules include:

- Sustainability Module on Climate Change & Renewable Energy was held on April 27th, 2023 at the US Department of Energy's Brookhaven National Laboratory
- Info-tech, Cyber Security & Artificial Intelligence Module coming October 2023 – held at Google's NYC HQ based Code Next Labs
